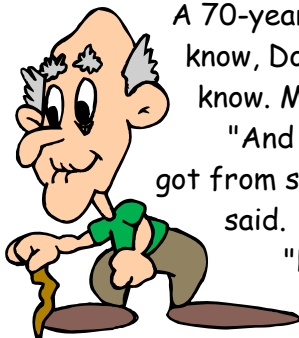

FROM THE SECRETARY'S DESK

Welcome to new and old committee members. I am looking forward to another great year with the club. It is great coming along every month and seeing new and old members alike enjoying the runs - after all - that is what our club is all about.

In my duty as duly elected club Secretary, I have outlined below the necessary requirements for nominations for Lifetime Membership for existing members and new members who would like clarification.

As per our constitution: (amended on 9/11/2003) as per committee meeting - minutes of which were moved and passed at the AGM of Sunday 9th November 2003.

Honorary Life Members: any member who has rendered service of outstanding merit may, on the recommendation of the committee, be elected an Honorary Life Member by a majority of not less than two-thirds of the members present at an Annual General Meeting. Honorary Life Members shall enjoy all the rights and privileges of ordinary members:

- (1) Nominations by club members to put forward another members name for Honorary Life membership must be made by filling out a Nomination Form obtainable from the club Secretary.
- (2) Member nominated for HLM **MUST BE** an active, participating member of the club of no less than 5 years.
- (3) The nominating member must list reasons as to why the nominee should be made an HLM of the club.
- (4) The committee will respond to nominations in writing if the nominee is not successful in obtaining HLM for the member nominated.
- (5) Nominations for HLM must be forwarded to the club Secretary no later than 14 days before the AGM of the nominated year so that club members can vote at the Annual General Meeting to accept or deny HLM of the nominee.

***The constitution did read:*

*If committee accepts nomination, said nomination stating reasons to be published in the journal prior to the AGM at which not less than two-thirds members must agree. Voting by said nomination to be by written ballot***

As this particular paragraph contradicted itself - you could not send in a nomination form 14 days before AGM **AND** have the nomination in the previous newsletter - this particular reference regarding HLM was omitted.

These by-laws were outlined in the minutes of the AGM on 9 November 2003. All members attending the AGM passed the motion.

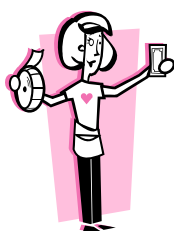

It was certainly not the intention of the committee to cause any undue distress or embarrassment to either Don or Phyllis. After receiving a letter to nominate both Malcolm & Trevor for lifetime membership, the committee had to have an extraordinary meeting to discuss guidelines pertaining to lifetime membership as no criteria had been set in relation to CHACC. Any member nominating someone for lifetime membership must list reasons as to why the nominee should be made a life member. This is not only to outline the nominee's achievements within the club, but also to let new and existing members know the achievements of the nominee. If I can be of assistance with any queries any members may have regarding Honorary Lifetime Membership, please do not hesitate to talk to me either on a run or by phone.

Minutes of previous meetings, AGM's etc. are all filed and kept for reference for any member to view by prior arrangement.

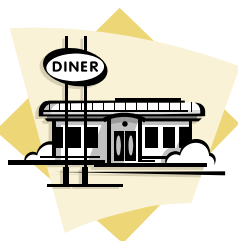

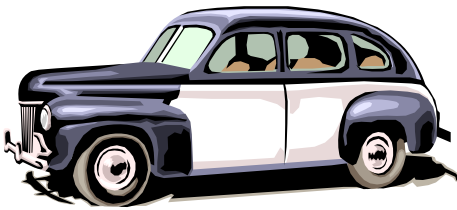

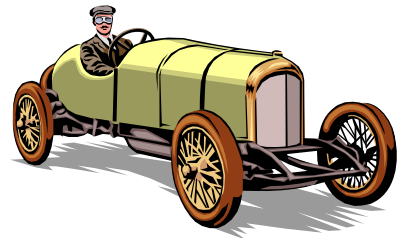
