Minutes of the last Rally meeting: Published In SCN - signed off on 26th September 08. All previous minutes are available for perusal @ every Rally

Treasurer's Report: Read out by Robyn. Available at Rally and will be included in SCN as an attachment with the committee minutes.

Business arising from the previous Rally minutes:

- Suncorp - John & Robyn have closed our fixed deposits into a Business a/c - no fees and when all outstanding cheques are presented, our C'wealth a/c will also be closed and balance of those funds will also be rolled into our new Suncorp Business a/c.
- Members who have not renewed their memberships by the end of October, will not be receiving any further SCN's.
- Our amended constitution has been forwarded to the Dept of Justice and is awaiting approval before we can send out to members.
- CHACC's books have been audited and returned and the report is ready for presentation at our forthcoming AGM.

Did you Know?

CHACA Classic & Historic Automobile Club of Australia started in Melbourne in 1966 and here in Brisbane in 1971 as CHACA Brisbane branch.

CHACA Caboolture branch commenced in July 1982, their first president was Graham Webb. Other founding members were Trevor Reibelt, Darren & Mark Faithful, Graham Knight, Bill Henderson & Malcolm McLeod. They held their first meeting at Graham Webb's house. Other meeting venues were Meals on Wheels Hall, Caboolture High School, Morayfield Highschool and Caboolture Special school. They held their last meeting under CHACA Melbourne on 11th November 2001. So they had been going for over 19 years. They then elected their new office bearers under **CHACC** and commenced organising their own constitution and by-laws. Therefore the Classic & Historical Automobile Club of Caboolture will be 8 years old this December.

CHACA Brisbane branch ceased in June 2001 and merged with Caboolture branch of CHACA.
