






























Mid-month run on Wednesday 11th February

We therefore need to get your okay on this at a Special General Meeting - which requires 14 days' notice. As this notice won't be adequate for our March 1st run, we will hope for a quorum at our March 11th midweek run to validate the changes. We require 15 members. If not, as we've waited this long, we will call our April 1st run a Special Meeting to okay these "Classes of Members". Hopefully we can then get the amended constitution okayed by the DFT and out to members. Please note our March 11th mid-week run is a Special General Meeting and if needed, notice is hereby given that our April 1st Rally run will be a Special General Meeting.


