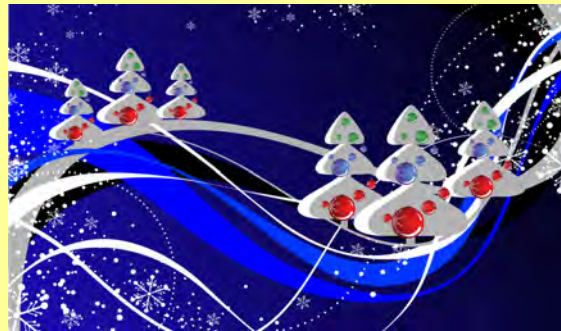

Secretary's Annual Report:

As of 31st October, CHACC have 166 financial members, and another 25 members who have not as yet renewed this year. Although this is marginally down on last year, we now appear to be welcoming a couple of new members each month, which is encouraging.

I believe we have had a successful year, even though we are showing a small loss for the year on income over expenditure. Contributing factors were memberships and the amount CHACC have donated to charities this year. I believe this is one function of what we should be all about (apart from enjoying each other's company and cars). Making our members' efforts towards our raffles worthwhile. We continue to give back to the members who attend rallies and have increased our contribution to local community organisations.

They have again put their hand up - in fact they were the first members to fill in a nomination form voluntarily this year. Thank you both, it is members like you that we need.
