# QLD HISTORIC MOTORING COUNCIL NEWS.....

JANUARY 2010

*Extracts from January 28th General Meeting Minutes*

## Robert Shannons Trust Grant

The purpose of the grant is to encourage people under the age of 30 to become involved in the restoration and preservation of veteran, vintage, post-vintage, historic 50's, historic 60's and historic 70's vehicles up to 30 years old. Grants are awarded to

- Help with the purchase of specialist tools or equipment
- Assist with the actual cost of restoration work
- Contribute toward TAFE or other fees
- Contribute toward any project considered worthwhile by the Trustees

Any person or group of people under the age of thirty years and engaged in studying automotive restoration and preservation or actively working on historic vehicles is eligible to be nominated for a grant. Affiliated clubs can complete and submit an application form for an eligible individual or group. The club must then forward the application to the QHMC for submission to the Trust.

In 2010, applications must be in the hands of the QHMC by 15<sup>th</sup> April 2010, applications can be downloaded from the QHMC website at [http://www.qhmc.org.au/robert\\_shannons\\_trust.htm](http://www.qhmc.org.au/robert_shannons_trust.htm)

**New Road Rule:** No children under seven in any cars unless the correct child restraint is fitted to the vehicle. Section 266 part 16 of the rules for persons travelling in or on vehicles. The Transport Operations Regulation 2009 (Road Use Management Road Rules) details the requirements for the wearing of seatbelts by passengers under 16 years old. It basically says that anyone under the age of 16 must wear a seatbelt or approved child restraint (the section details the types of restraint based on the child's age). Section 267 Part 16 covers exemptions from wearing seatbelts. It states in subsection (1A) that a person in or on a motor vehicle is exempt from wearing a seatbelt if \_\_\_

- (a) The seating position that the person occupies is not fitted with a seatbelt; and
- (b) There is no requirement for that seating position to be fitted with a seatbelt; and
- (c) All passengers in the vehicle who are exempt from a seatbelt are complying with subsection (8)

However, subsection (1B) of this section states that Subsection (1A) does not apply to a person who is under 7 years old.

This means that unless the vehicle is fitted with seatbelts and approved child restraint devices, a child under seven (7) years old **cannot** be carried in the vehicle.

**E10 Fuel Mandate:** The QHMC has submitted a case that requires large service stations to retain unleaded petrol (ULP) as part of the Government's mandate that is 5% of all fuel to be Ethanol.
