Thank you, Ita and Hudson for arranging the run. We were behind them on the way home and had trouble keeping up with Hudson!!!

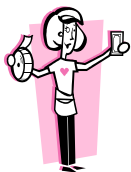
To all the people who did not attend due to illness, get well soon - you were missed and we look forward to catching up with you when you are well.

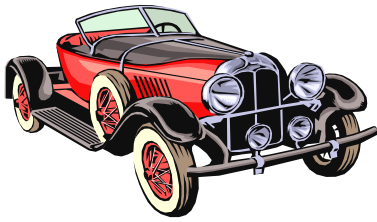

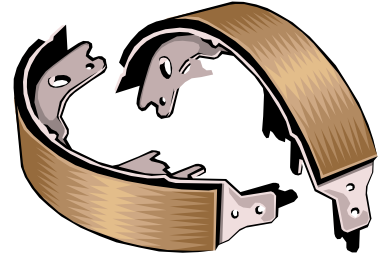
