

#### The Bank Manager wants to see you

Hi Everyone,

The book is finished at last and copies should be available in a couple of weeks. At last, after almost three years of hard work and gaining a whole new respect for authors, I have finished writing my memoirs, *'The Bank Manager Wants to See You'*. The finished copy is A4 size, contains 340 pages, 150,000 words and in excess of 300 photos and illustrations



It begins with a brief family history and then evolves into social history. I've recorded memories of growing up in the forties and fifties and through my twenty-three year career

as a bank officer/manager with the Commercial Banking Company of Sydney. I worked throughout Victoria and New South Wales in seventy-nine different branches, including small country towns where I met many interesting 'characters'. I've also included Australian history, amusing incidents and details of appliances now considered antique and long forgotten methods of doing things.

Reviews of my book appear to indicate that it has general appeal, especially to people of my era who can relate to the events described and it will, I hope, give later generations an insight into what life was like in an earlier and quite different era.
