To all Car Enthusiasts,

I am writing this with great sadness over the loss of my body identification plates of my EH Premier Sedan that is the number 2 off the assembly line. The body identification places have been stolen off my car and I would like them back. I would like to ask you for your help so they can be returned to me or so they cannot be used by the person that has stolen them from me.

The body identification place was off my EH Premier Sedan: body identification number 235A and Number 2. As there in only one EH Premier 235A number 2, there cannot be another one. I am asking you, your club and your members please keep an eye out so they cannot profit from my loss, as I cannot register my EH Premier now as I have no body identification plates.
