Seat Belts and Child Restraints It is now well known that Queensland refused to follow the lead set by the National Transport Commission and the Australian Transport Council by not adopting the model Australian Road Rules in full http://www.legislation.qld.gov.au/LEGISLTN/CURRENT/T/TrantOpRURR09.pdf The exemption provided in Australian Road Rules allowing the carriage of 7 to under16 year olds in pre-seat belt era vehicles not already retrofitted is not available for any vehicle travelling in Queensland. Club consultation has resulted in overwhelming opinion that a reasonable point in time for an exemption to the 7 to under 16 age group would be for all pre-1960 vehicles. OHMC will advocate accordingly.

No-cost registration for Veterans: QHMC is preparing a case for no-cost registration for Veteran vehicles, perhaps even a 100 year rolling date from a determined point in time. 
REPORT ON THE CANCER COUNCIL RALLY - Submitted by fellow member Richard Jefferay

Firstly a BIG thank you to ALL C.H.A.C.C. members for their support with our fundraising efforts for the "Shitbox Rally 2011" for the Cancer Council.

We left Brisbane's Breakfast Creek Hotel on Saturday 21st May, heading west via Toowoomba. There was quite a line up of very interesting "bombs". The participants were just as interesting – some dressed in tuxedos, some as brides, even a panda or two. We were just as keen to see them as we were to see the cars lined up ready to hit the road. the Qantas Aircraft Museum?!


Our camps included Hell's Gate, Daly Waters, Gregory Downs & Katherine and we even

This was only the second year of this Rally, growing in strength from 28 cars to over 100. The Rally total was \$740,280.90 – a very impressive achievement.
