Annual General Meeting (AGM) Storey Brook Cottage 30th October 2011

Meeting opened by President at 8:35 AM, who welcomed all attending members to this important meeting.

Attendance and apologies: As per the attendance sheet signed by all members.

Minutes of previous AGM:

Minutes of 2010 AGM held at the Woodford Hotel on Sunday 31st October 2010 were tabled (and had been published in SCN after the meeting). Moved: Jan Beatson, Seconded Kim Bower that they be accepted as a true and correct record of that meeting – Carried.

Business Arising: There was none raised.

President's Annual Report:

The President summarised what was a successful year for the club. He stressed to members that for our club to run efficiently, members should consider joining the committee, as without these important members, our club would no longer be able to function. Committee positions can only be held for two years. The President also voiced his appreciation to the outgoing committee members for their untiring efforts during the year, to the members who had organised all the interesting runs we went on, to Alf & Jenny D'Acunto for their fund raising and raffles, and to Wendy Dooly for her outstanding efforts as our newsletter editor.

Treasurer's Report:

Our Treasurer (Lindsay Bell) tabled the Audit Report from Allison Kropp (Independent Auditor), and moved that it be accepted as a true and correct record of the financial status of the club, seconded Alex Gallacher – carried.

Secretary's Report:

Jan Beatson reported that we currently have a membership totalling 144 members (12 new members this year) and 26 members who have not yet renewed their membership. We have had a good year with our runs with many interesting places visited. Attendance has been encouraging for both Sunday and mid-week outings and we also attended many car shows, fetes etc., to allow our members to show off their pride and joy. Thanks to John Pritchard and Jan Blake, we now have a new website up and running with features designed to encourage member interaction. Thanks to Alf & Jenny for their excellent work in running our raffles (\$1038.20 raised) and our Sergeant-at-Arms Elaine Gallacher raising \$110.50. From these proceeds and other club funds we donated \$1000 (via sponsorship of Richard & Shirley Jeffray's run to the N.T.) to the Cancer Council. We also purchased and presented a new lap top computer to the Burpengary Riding for the Disabled Organisation to replace equipment lost in the January floods. The balance of the raffle proceeds and monies raised in fines will also go to this charity. Jan also expressed her appreciation to Carol Bowers for her help during the year.

Unfortunately, due to ill health, Jan will be unable to continue in her position in 2011/12, and wished the incoming committee all the best for the coming year.

Life Memberships:

The committee received two nominations for Life Memberships but were unable to consider them as they were not submitted within the 14 day deadline required before the AGM and were deferred until 2012.

Club Member of the Year:

Brenda Byrnes was nominated as Returning officer and after all members had voted in a secret ballot, it was announced that Wendy Dooley had been voted Club Member of the Year for 2010/2011.



Election of Chairperson for AGM:

The President proposed that Andy Byrne chair the meeting until the new committee was elected – seconded Ron Byrnes. All positions were declared vacant and the president vacated the chair in favour of Andy, who congratulated the outgoing committee for their efforts during the past 12 months and called for nominations.

President Nominations:

No written nominations received – Alex Gallacher was nominated from the floor by Ron Byrnes and Graham Beatson, Alex accepted, elected unopposed.

Vice President Nominations:

No written nominations received – Alf D’Acunto nominated by Wendy Dooley and Alex Gallacher. Alf accepted – elected unopposed.

No written nominations received – Jenny D’Acunto nominated by Ron Byrnes and Wendy Dooley. Jenny accepted – elected unopposed.

Treasurer:

No written nominations received – Valmay Bell nominated by Alex Gallacher and Jenny D’Acunto. Valmay accepted – elected unopposed

This concluded the election of the main committee members and Andy vacated the chair in favour of the new President and wished the club continued success in the coming year.
