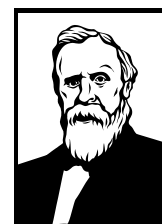

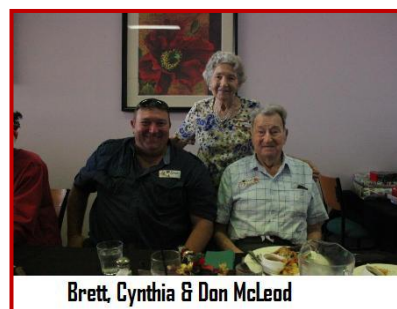

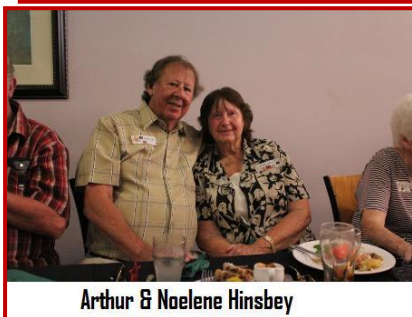

Australia Day 26th January 2014

Caboolture Historical Village

To clarify any confusion that may occur about our Australia Day run, the preferred CHACC run will be to Samford Historical Museum.

However, if some members do not want to travel that far and wish to attend the Caboolture Historical Village on the same day, you would be covered under our CHACC conditions and you should arrive at the village by 8.45am. It is expected that by 2pm all activities for cars will be complete and you will be able to leave the site around this time. Alternatively you may peel off after the 1pm Grand Parade. Entries via Gate 4 BEFORE 9am. Entry is free and there will be food stalls for lunch if you don't wish to BYO. Attached invitation and more details for you.

Again, the main CHACC run for this day will be to Samford Historical Village, details below:-

Samford Historical Museum

Early start assembling at Sundowner at 8.00am and leaving at 8.30am.

We will be proceeding down the Bruce Highway and taking the exit at Linkfield Road (next one past the Strathpine exit) and continuing along Southpine Road, then turning right into Eatons Crossing Rd, up over Clear Mountain and then left into Mt Samsom Rd then into Samford where we turn right into Station Street (directly opposite the hotel). The entry gate is just prior to the main Museum entrance.

This should take us about half to three quarters of an hour and we will arrive prior to our 9 am requirement. Some may wish to join up with us along the route.

We need an idea of numbers to let the organisers know for catering. Free sausage sizzle for lunch. Please phone Graham on 33859898 to confirm if you will be attending.

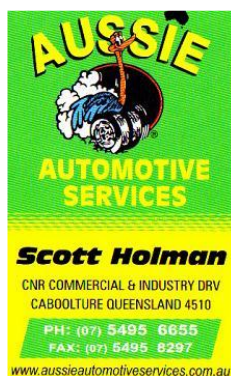

Recipe

Macaroni Cheese

1 cup pasta
1 tablespoon butter
1 onion, diced
1 tablespoon plain flour
½ cup milk
1 cup grated cheese
Salt and pepper



Cook pasta following packet directions. Melt butter in saucepan, and add onion. Sauté on medium heat until onion is clear, turn heat to low. Add flour and mix well until the butter and flour is blended. Gradually add milk, blending well after each addition, to form a paste. Turn up the heat to medium and keep mixing until thickened and heated well. Do not allow to simmer or boil. Add grated cheese and mix until mixture has reached a smooth consistency, and is glossy and creamy. Drain the pasta well, and add to sauce, which will thicken on standing. Add salt and pepper to taste, and serve.

It is important to make sure you don't at any stage let the sauce get too hot, this will dry it out and then you will end up with a really grainy texture or really gloopy sauce. It is the perfect meal for rainy days
