

Recipe Spinach & Bacon Mini Quiche

Puff pastry
4 rashers bacon, diced
4 eggs
1 onion, diced
3 large Spinach leaves, shredded
1 cup grated cheese
Salt & pepper

Pre heat oven to 180c. Grease muffin tray. In medium saucepan, brown onion and bacon. Turn off the heat and add spinach so that the heat wilts it. Add all other ingredients and mix well.

Cut circles from the puff pastry to fit inside muffin tin. Place pastry in the muffin tin holes and spoon in 2 teaspoons of the mixture.

Makes about 24

Bake for approximately 20 minutes or until firm and browned


Did You Know?

A car accident in 1952 involving John Hetrick, his wife and daughter was the catalyst for the industrial engineer to develop a system to protect drivers and passengers – the airbag. In those days drivers were unprotected in accidents, and impacts could result in serious injuries. Those who survive often had badly mutilated faces, which doctors darkly nicknamed "steering wheel face". nearly 30 years later Airbags were used in vehicle.


Airbag moves up to 4500 mph within a second when triggered. A force of 200g is generated. They are designed to explode at an impact speed of 19 mph. The bag inflates within 40 milliseconds of a crash.
