## **Did You Know?**

The cheapest car of all time was the 1922 Red Bug, built by the Briggs Stratton Co. of Milwaukee, Wisconsin, USA, listed at \$125-\$150. It had a wheelbase of 1.57m (62in) and weighed 111kg (245lb). Early models of the King Midget cars were sold in kit form for self-assembly for as little as \$100 in 1948.



## Recipe

**Mars Bar Slice** 

50g butter
1 tbls golden syrup
4 x 53g mars bars, finely chopped
3 cups (60g) rice bubbles
200g milk chocolate
20g copha



Grease and line the base and side of a 19 x 29cm slice pan with baking paper, allowing the sides to overhang. Combine the butter, golden syrup and three-quarters of the mars bars in a medium saucepan over low heat. Cook, stirring with a wooden spoon, for 5 minutes or until mars bars and butter melt and mixture is smooth. Remove from heat. Place the rice bubbles and remaining mars bar in a large bowl. Add the mars bar mixture and stir until well combined. Spoon into the prepared pan and use the back of a spoon to smooth the surface. Set aside for 1 hour to cool completely. Place the chocolate and copha in a heatproof bowl over a saucepan half-filled with simmering water, stir until chocolate melts. Pour chocolate over the top of the slice to evenly coat. Set aside for 30 minutes to set. Cut into squares.


