### Recipe Creamy Garlic Pasta with Chicken & Broccoli

2 Cups pasta, cooked and drained
2 shallots, minced
4 cloves garlic, minced
Salt and pepper to taste
1 Tablesp olive oil
3 Tablesp flour
2 ½ Cups almond milk
2 boneless chicken breasts, cooked and cut into bite-sized pieces
1 Cup broccoli, steamed



In a saucepan, heat oil and sauté shallots and garlic until fragrant and translucent. Whisk in flour and cook for about a minute to brown. Gradually whisk in milk and season with salt and pepper. Simmer until mixture thickens to desired consistency. Toss pasta with sauce, chicken, and broccoli.
