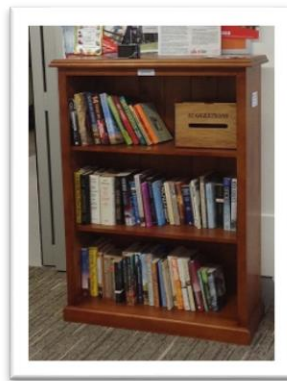

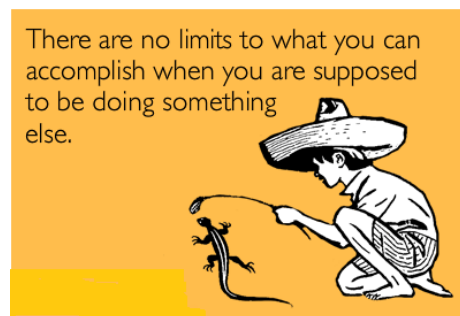


## **BUM A RIDE** Feel like catching up with your CHACC mates but don't feel like driving?

### Recipe Anzac Biscuits

1 cup rolled oats  
1 cup flour  
½ cup sugar  
¾ cup coconut  
125g butter  
2 tablespoons golden syrup  
½ teaspoon bi carbonate of soda  
1 tablespoon boiling water



Combine oats, flour, sugar, and coconut in a bowl. Place butter and golden syrup into a saucepan, over low heat, melt butter; add bi carbonate and water to syrup. Add syrup mix to dry ingredients, mix well. Place tablespoons of mixture on to lightly greased tray. Bake at 150°C for 20 minutes
