

Recipe Orange Cake

125g butter softened
1/4 cup milk
1/4 cup orange juice
2 egg
3/4 cup caster sugar
1 1/2 cup self-raising flour sifted
1 tbsp. orange zest

Orange Icing

1/3 cup butter softened1 ½ cup icing sugar sifted1 to 2 tbsp. orange juice½ tsp orange zest

Combine all cake ingredients and beat thoroughly for 3 minutes. Pour mixture into a greased 20 cm x 10 cm loaf or 20 cm ring tin. Bake at 180C for 30-40 minutes. Turn onto wire rack and allow to cool. Ice with orange icing.
