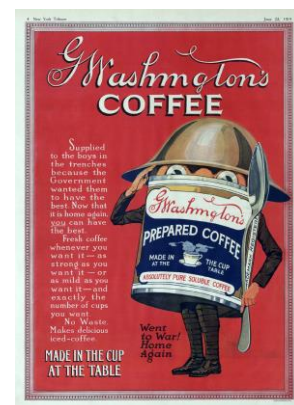
## Did You Know?

In 1901, the first successful technique for manufacturing a stable powdered coffee was invented in Japan by Sartori Kato, who used a process he had developed for making instant tea.

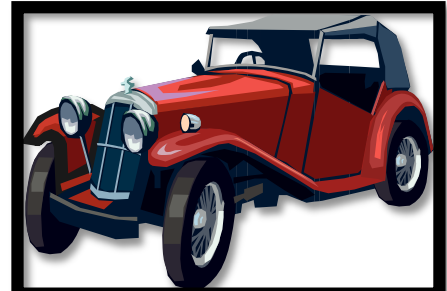
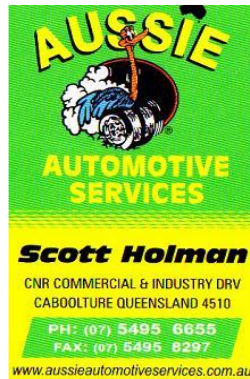
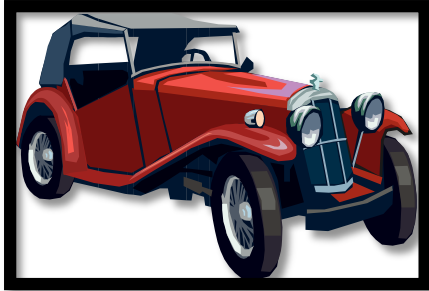

## Recipe Orange Cake

125g butter softened  
¼ cup milk  
¼ cup orange juice  
2 egg  
¾ cup caster sugar  
1 ½ cup self-raising flour sifted  
1 tbsp. orange zest

### Orange Icing

⅓ cup butter softened  
1 ½ cup icing sugar sifted  
1 to 2 tbsp. orange juice  
½ tsp orange zest

Combine all cake ingredients and beat thoroughly for 3 minutes.  
Pour mixture into a greased 20 cm x 10 cm loaf or 20 cm ring tin.  
Bake at 180C for 30-40 minutes.  
Turn onto wire rack and allow to cool.  
Ice with orange icing.

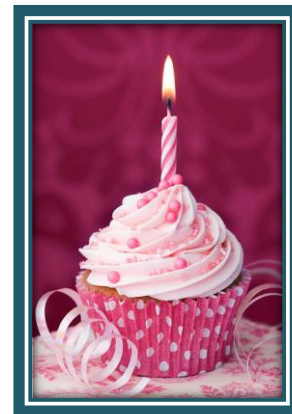
