Yes, he has a CNC router (computer numerically controlled – for those of us who didn't know). Even the chassis was manufactured in house by Steve. This creation will be on show at the Hot Rod Expo in Brisbane on the 23<sup>rd</sup> & 24<sup>th</sup> May at the Brisbane & Exhibition Centre, Southbank – dates well worth remembering to see the end result!

From 'Just Gerberas' we took the quick route to Cruice Park to have lunch. Turns out we didn't need Alex (who was in Melbourne) to set a precedent for how many Subway lunches turned out. Seven of us managed to snag a Subway lunch. (pretty good too).
