Kim & I relished the fact we were going to some place we hadn't been before. The ambience of Witta made us look it up and our research showed in the 2011census, it had a population of just 1230. It was first settled around 1887 by German immigrant families. They called it Teutoberg (also spelled Teutoburg), possibly referring to the Teutoburg Forest area in Germany. The town renamed in 1916 during World War 1 due to anti-German sentiment. The name Witta is a corruption of the word "wetya" meaning dingo in the Kabi language. It is situated 39kilometres SW of Nambour within the Blackall Ranges. We loved it – thank you Aileen & Neils.
