This Month's Car Facts

Carl Benz is credited as inventing the automobile as something entirely designed as such to generate its own power, not simply a motorized stage coach or horse carriage, which is why he was granted his patent and is regarded as its inventor. The Motorwagen was patented on 29 January 1886 as DRP-37435: "automobile fueled by gas".

Whale oil was actually used in some car transmissions until 1973

Using the actual formula for horsepower (1 HP = power needed to lift 550 lbs. 1 ft. in 1 sec.), the average horse, over a longer period of time, will only produce around .7HP. Currently, a typical compact car will contain a 150HP engine; or the horsepower contained in around 214 horses.
