We're presently finalising the communication channels which will see us up to speed by next edition and able to keep you informed on CHACC happening.

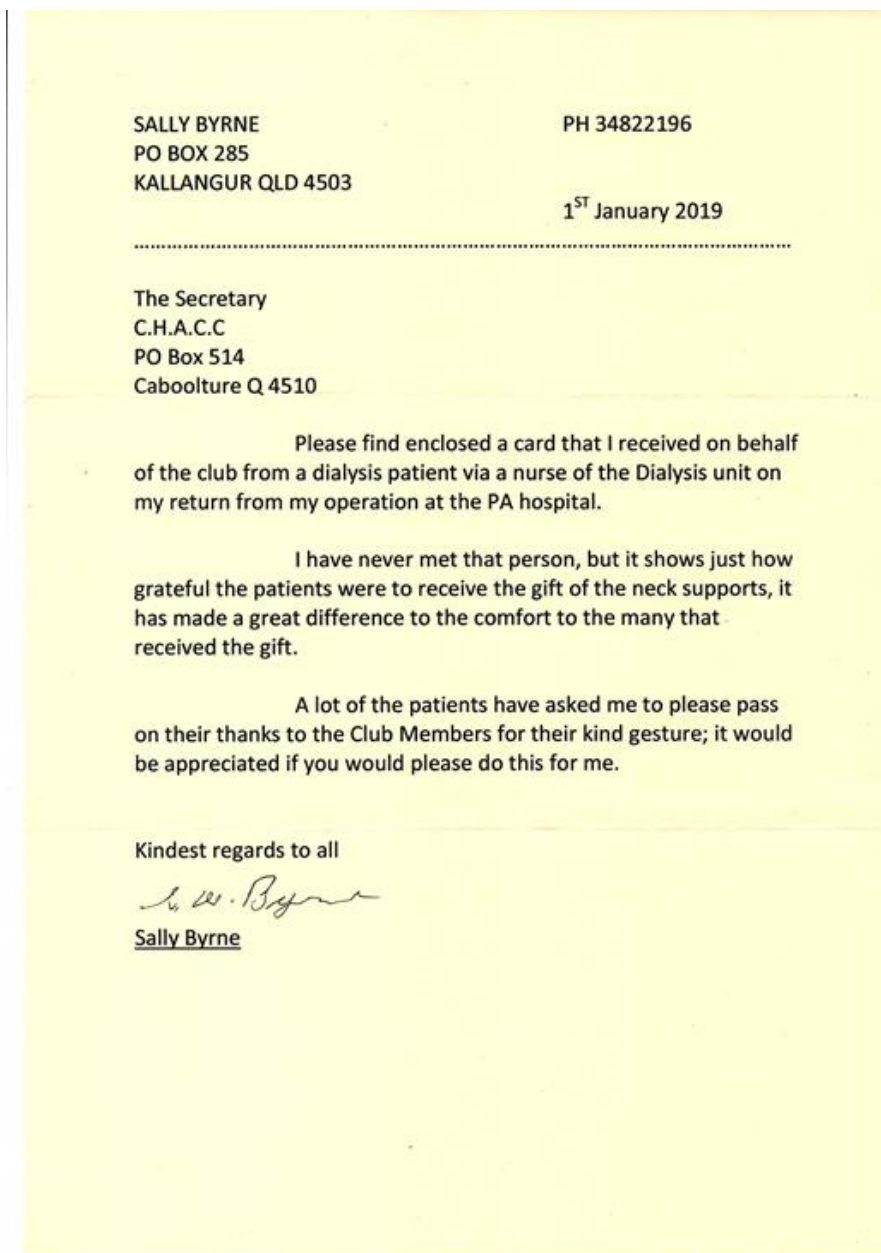
During the end of year time out Alex has been keeping you informed of some of the information you will have been interested in and I'm sure there will be more in other parts of this issue.

Sweet potato and crumbed chicken salad

- 800g gold sweet potato, cut into rounds
- 1/4 cup olive oil
- 1 teaspoon fennel seeds
- 1 tablespoon rosemary leaves
- 400g pkt Chicken Breast Fingers
- 1/4 cup dried cranberries
- 1/4 cup pine nuts, toasted
- 60g Baby Rocket
- 1 tablespoon olive oil, extra, to serve
- 2 tablespoons red wine vinegar



Preheat oven to 200C. Line a large baking tray with baking paper. Arrange the sweet potato in a single layer on the lined tray. Drizzle with oil. Sprinkle with fennel and rosemary. Cook for 30 mins. Add the chicken to the tray. Cook for 10 mins or until sweet potato is tender and chicken is cooked through. Meanwhile, place the cranberries in a bowl and pour over enough cold water to cover. Set aside for 10 mins to soak. Drain.

Arrange the sweet potato, chicken and rocket on a serving platter. Sprinkle with the cranberries and pine nuts. Combine oil and vinegar in a small bowl. Drizzle over the salad to serve.
