Happy New Year to all members, on the 21st and 22nd of December 2021 C.H.A.C.C. delivered to Dialysis Patients at the Qld Health Precinct North Lakes 72 bamboo Neck Pillows, this was achieved by 4 members on 21st with the assistance of Manager & Nursing staff of the dialysis unit to the AM shift the remainder for the 21st were delivered by the Nursing staff to the Patients during the day, the next day 22nd same procedure again was carried out as per previous day by group of 4.

It has been heartening to see how this gift has been received by the patients & their carer's this has already made a difference to many patients during their time receiving Dialysis treatment, patients treatment times vary depending on their condition from 4 hours to 5.5 hours this is a long time to sit - lay still, this neck pillow – cushion has helped to provide comfort during their treatment time and not forgetting time taken prior to start and time taken to finish after their treatment time has been completed, many compliments have been received back to the nurses.

This Gift by the members has assisted many at a difficult time to some, well done by the results of the "SALLY'S HAT" carried by Toosje Davis Fund Raising efforts obtaining donations from club members during the year and the contribution from CHACC management topping up the fund so 72 Pillows could be purchased to cover ALL patients receiving Dialysis treatment a great effort by all concerned, it was necessary for all members to follow health guidelines including name tags attending to the handing out of the gift as you will note in photos included, even Schelly Skelton had an official name tag.

SYDNEY, Wed.: The NSW Minister for Transport, Mr Morris, will ask General Motors-Holden for performance details of a new car said to be capable of 125 mph.

The new model, said to be a four-door GTS sedan, is due for release in three weeks with optional V8 engines, ranging in power from 185 to 300 bhp.

It is reported the fastest version will sell for about \$4500.

The NSW Parliamentary Labor Party's transport spokesman, Mr Peter Cox, today called for a ban on the car's registration.

"It would be completely irresponsible to place a mass-produced vehicle capable of such a tremendous speed on the open market," he said.

The Royal Automobile Club of Victoria late last year sought the support of all Governments for a move to limit the speed capabilities of vehicles to 90 mph.
