CHACC MINUTES for General Meeting following the AGM Nov 5th 2023 Bribie Woodies Clubhouse



Meeting commenced: 11.30 am

President welcomed all those in attendance:

Present & Apologies: As per the Attendance Sheet

Treasurer's Report:

John had already read out for last month October 2023. John also mentioned as from March next year Suncorp will no longer deal with cheques. Kim suggested organising a Debit card. John to investigate and implement what is best for CHACC.

General Business:

1. Sally's Hat – Charity suggestions from members to donate to for 2023. Toosje Davis suggested Give-It who are currently assisting bush fire victims. Last Charity a couple of years ago CHACC donated to Give-It and all proceeds go directly to recipients, they do not take anything for administration. Kim asked members to think about it if they come up with any other suggestions, please get them to a committee member.



2. Kim said cost of catered for lunch was for 30-50 members \$27/head. We have already paid a deposit to secure the date of December 3rd. Will need numbers and menu selections by November 15th. Form was circulated to member's present to pop down their names. Anyone not attending the AGM to get their intention to come into Carol by 15th Nov. What would CHACC subsidise - Jenny Vallance suggested \$17 per head, member's to pay \$10. All in agreement. Kim stated that any subsidies CHACC contribute to come from our working account which member's donate to via memberships and raffles, they do NOT come from our Fixed Savers account.
3. Kim also suggested may be CHACC should again look at asking any new or existing members they must attend at least 2 or 3 runs per year to retain their membership. Sally Byrne said majority of all other clubs have that in practice already. Neils said – 'who would police that'?
4. Toosje Davis asked any members requiring Impromptu Run permission to either email or text her. That way they have written proof they have permission, where as a phone call, they have nothing to show for proof of acceptance. Andy also mentioned that the 15km rule has been increased to 30km allowed to take vehicle on non-Club run.
5. Club Marque – Kim mentioned this is 6 metres, very heavy and needs a ute for transporting. He suggested we sell on Marketplace and get a 3 metre one. 2nd. Alex – all in agreement.
6. Ken McFarlane went through the first 6 months of 2024 and a big thankyou to attending members as we have managed to fill the calendar up to the 13th June next year. First cab off the rank is Ken who will negotiate with Caboolture Historical Village for our Australia Day run.

Rocky Road Slice

500g good-quality milk cooking chocolate, broken into pieces

250g milk coffee biscuits, roughly chopped

100g marshmallows, chopped

100g red glace cherries, halved

Grease a 3cm-deep, 16.5cm x 26cm (base) slab pan. Line base and sides with baking paper, allowing a 2cm overhang at both long ends.

Place chocolate in a large, heatproof, microwave-safe bowl. Microwave, uncovered, on MEDIUM (50%) for 2 to 3 minutes, stirring every minute with a metal spoon, or until melted and smooth. Add biscuits, marshmallows and cherries. Stir until well combined. Press slice mixture into prepared pan. Refrigerate for 3 hours or until firm. Cut into large pieces. Serve.

During her life time Morrie has lived in Toowoomba, on The Gold Coast, at Glasshouse Mts and currently at Moorina. Bit of a gad-about!

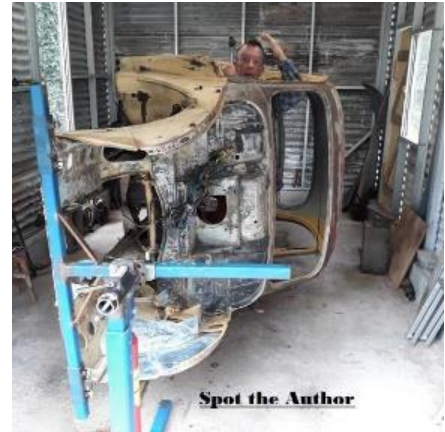
