A good day was had by 11 CHACC members plus 2 visitors from N.D.S.C.C.

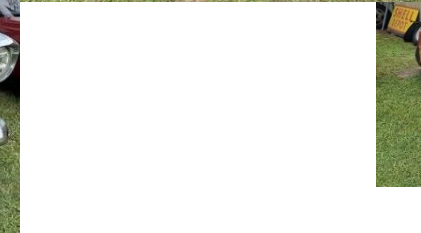

CHRISTMAS LUNCH 3rd DEC 2023

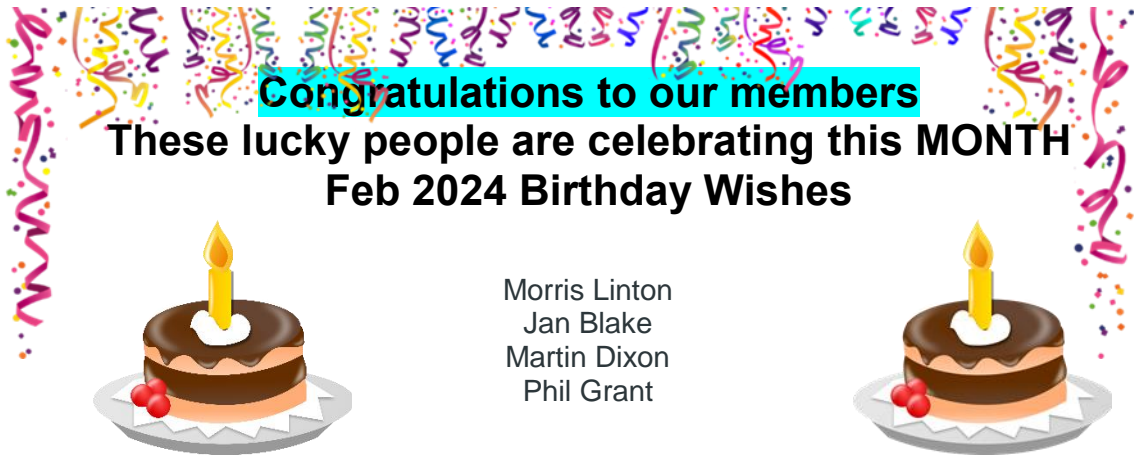

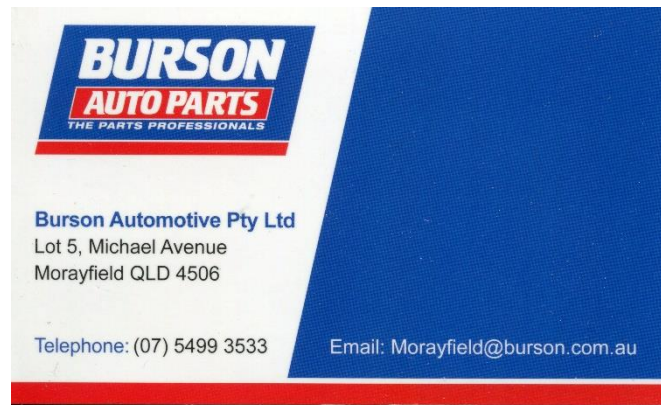

Recipe

Pumpkin, Fetta and Rocket Salad

3 cups pumpkin diced
¼ cup olive oil
2 tbs honey
1 tbs dried sage
100g fetta crumbled
1 cup rocket leaves
Chickpeas optional



Combine oil, honey and sage together and toss through pumpkin.
Bake pumpkin in a 220C oven for 30 minutes until starting to brown, then allow to cool, making sure oil is kept in the bottom of the dish.
Toss the pumpkin, feta and rocket with the oil.
