

## Passionfruit Slice

BASE TOPPING

395g condensed milk 1 cup self-raising

flour 3 passionfruits 1 cup coconut

1/2 cup sugar


125g butter melted



Melt butter and add to flour, coconut and sugar.

Mix well and press into pan. Bake for 15 minutes at 180C. Cool
